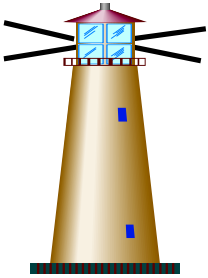

There will be a special connection made to the past as we remember how we are united with all the saints down through the ages since Jesus instituted this sacrament for our salvation. The theme of the day will be "Capturing the Story", as we begin to celebrate the call of God for the Wallace Church to become a mission station for His Kingdom and all of us as missionaries for the Lord's purpose in the communities we live, work, and play within. Sunday, October 17

The theme of the day for our worship services will be "The Unfolding Story", as we continue to hear about the mission that has unfolded through the years through the membership of Wallace. We will be able to watch and listen to her as she plays our historic and wonderful sounding pipe organ (restored and expanded within the last five years). It will be a great way to share an evening as we celebrate the importance of our music program as a part of our ministry and mission. 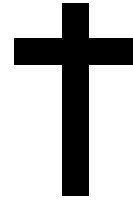

Annual Winter Coat Drive

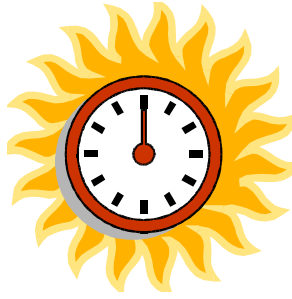
Winter coats are needed for South Hills Interfaith Ministries families.
